AIR DRY CLAY TURTLES



- Air dry clay
- Paint
- PVA

Eyes

EQUIPMENT

METHOD

1. Start by taking a chunk of clay about the size of a lime (you can make these *any* size).
2. Place it between your palms, moving them forward and backward, forming the clay into a long, skinny, rope-like shape. When you're done, lay it flat on the table.
3. Time to coil it up! Grab one end and turn it inside itself, rolling it from one side to the other (it will look like a cinnamon roll).
4. Once done, you can roll out smaller pieces of clay and create the base of your turtle, a head and 4 fins.
5. Place the coil over the top of the head and 4 pins and push together so they remain attached.
6. Push 2 eyes into the head of the turtle. Allow clay to dry

WEEK 2 - Once the clay is dry, paint your turtle. Once the paint is dry, cover the turtle with a layer of PVA glue to create a glossy look.
