



# ARTS & CRAFTS PLAN

## TIN FOIL FISH



## EQUIPMENT

Card / Cardboard  
String or wool  
Tin foil

Scissors  
Felt tip pens  
Tape

## METHOD

Cut out a basic fish shape out of cardboard / card.

Cut small slits along the top and bottom edge of the fish's body about 2cm apart (this is to hold the wool in place.)

Secure one end of the wool on the back of the fish with tape.

Wrap the wool around the body of the fish between the cut slit, in different directions so your fish has sections on it's body.

Tape the other end of the wool down when you've finished.

Get a large square of tinfoil and carefully place over the body of your fish, wrapping the edges over the side of the fish to secure. Gently press down onto the tinfoil so it is pressed into the different sections.

Once the tinfoil is in place, colour in the different sections with pens to make a scale effect. Add fins and a tail!
